




2012 Health Insurance Coverage Percent Insured

Small Area Health Insurance Estimates

The U.S. Census Bureau's Small Area Health Insurance Estimates (SAHIE) program produces model-based estimates of health insurance coverage for counties and states. Individuals are considered insured if they were covered by any type of health insurance coverage for part or all of the previous year (including Medicaid and CHIP participation but excluding people with no coverage other than access to Indian Health Service)
